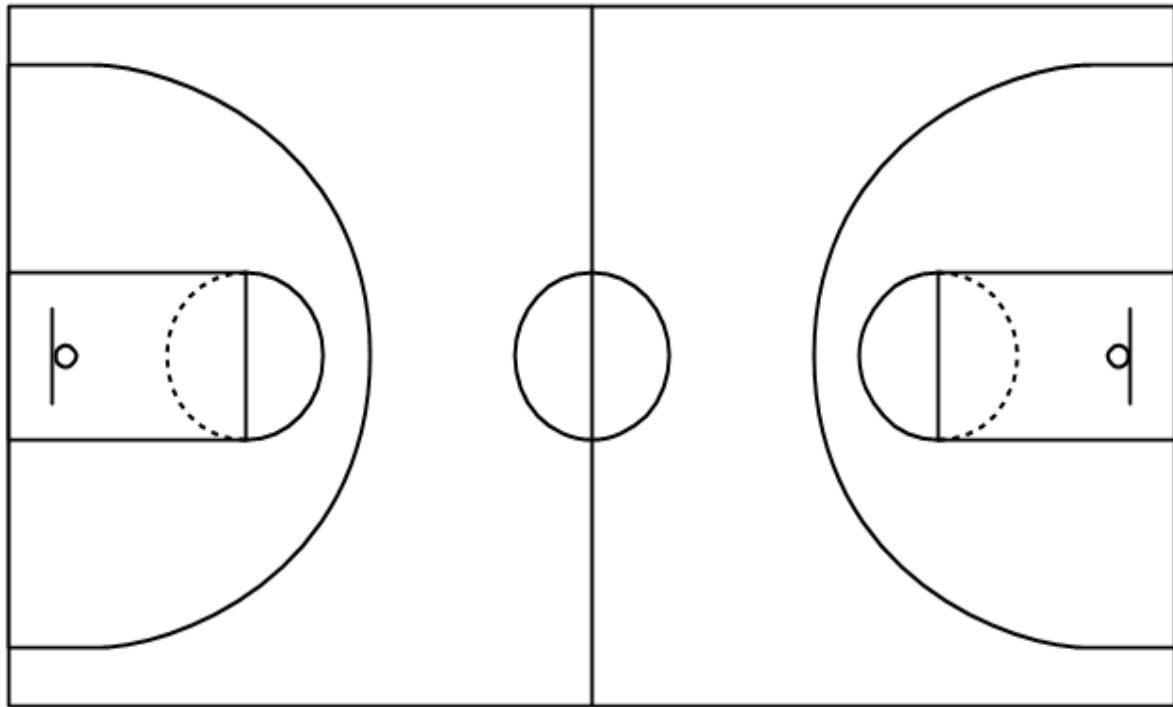

Label 5 key features of the basketball court.



**Glossary of Terms** - Match the term to the correct definition.

Dunk	When a player takes more than 3 steps without dribbling
Free Throw	Charging foul occurs when an offensive player makes significant contact with a defensive player who has both feet on ground and is facing forward.
Technical foul	When a player ends their dribble by catching or causing the ball to come to rest in one or both hands and then dribbles it again
Jump shot	A breach of the rules that concerns illegal personal contact with another player
Charge	An attempt at a goal that cannot be defended awarded to a player following a foul or other infringement
Personal foul	A shot made while jumping.
Travelling	A goal scored by shooting the ball down through the basket with the hands above the rim.
Double dribble	A foul which does not involve contact between opponents.
